- Skills transfer regarding the identification and loading of OnDemand PTFs for the iSeries server and the latest fix packs for the OnDemand Client
- Skills transfer regarding the best methods for the creation of report definitions for *SCS and *AFPDS type spool files using Operations Navigator
- Skills transfer regarding the creation of AFP form overlays
- Review of OnDemand security including key security
- Review of the OnDemand archive process, including setting up OnDemand to monitor one or more iSeries output queues
- Review of the optical jukebox, loading platters, initializing volumes, associating volumes with OnDemand storage groups and ensuring the spool files and written to the correct platters
- Review of possible APIs and User Exits that can be used to integrate OnDemand with other business applications
- Review features and functions of the OnDemand Client
- Review of optional OnDemand features such as Common Server, OnDemand Web Enablement Kit and the PDF Indexer
- Begin creation of OnDemand report definitions for new spool files already contained in iSeries output queues
- Review a recommended optical platter backup and recovery procedure.
